The principal nods, the student comes in and before leaving, thanks the principal and wishes him a good day. This is a scene being enacted in Class VI of CU South Primary School at a session on Communicative English, meant to improve spoken English and etiquette.

Different from regular English lessons which teach reading and writing in English, students

are given a topic and they have to perform a skit, says Sharmada Nandan, a class VI student.

Mary Ann, instructor from the Institute of Language Man-

agement is working in some schools in Ahmedabad, teaching students to speak English. These schools have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with ILM, that has not trained faculty to orient students and help them in the usage of English.

Bela Mehta, the principal of CU South Primary School said, "we as adults fail to create an environment for our children to learn and speak English, with this MoU we have tried to create that environment".

per body language, etiquette and social skills. The teaching material includes dramatics, role plays and writing techniques, song, role play and other dramatics.

Richard Terezi, class VI student of CU South Primary School, says, "In only a month we have been attending these sessions, but the difference is evident already. We have started talking in English even in other classes". He is looking at to grow his students' scope to explore the creativity.

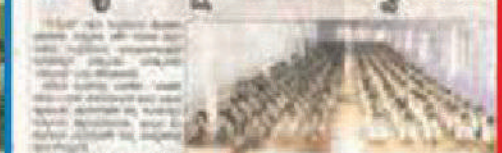
"We let the students make choices to carry out skits in the schools. They are given badges and points too. We conduct an English March, where the students create songs, dance, etc."

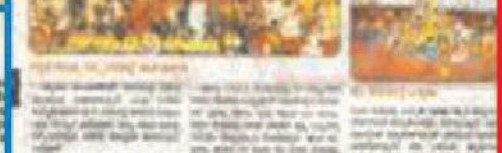

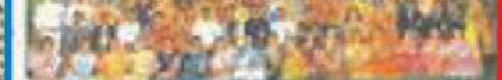
